Treasurer's Report

Dave Weber reported on the accounting and reconciliation activities he was responsible for over the past year. He provided a slide presentation of both income and expense figures for the prior fiscal year (2017-2018) as well as of the most recent fiscal year (2018-2019). He included some explanation of the nature of various expenses and steps taken to reduce /curtail expenses where possible. He also reviewed the status of cash accounts, including:

- Operating account
- Scrip
- Minister's discretionary fund
- Operating reserves
- Capital reserves

He ended by mentioning that financial success depends on everyone fulfilling their pledges on a timely basis.

Report of the Minister

Reverend Kent Doss recapped some salient points about the past and future years and discussed the purpose of the recently revived Comprehensive Planning Committee. He also mentioned the advantages of Rev. Rayna Hamre becoming an Affiliated Community Minister and how this will benefit Tapestry.

- Consideration and adoption of new operating budget – Paul Bonfanti, VP Finance, presented this information. He went over projected revenue and expense figures and we voted. M/S/P
- Vote on new slate of Board members for 2019-2020. M/S/P
- Vote on proposed Nominating Committee members. M/S/P
